

Table-Top Video Project



Description of the completed project

The completed project will be a 1 – 2 minute videotape program about a _____ topic. The program will begin with a graphic screen (10 seconds) that includes the title of your project and the student(s) name(s). Following the graphic screen will be an image videotaped using the table-top video system. The audio (sound) will consist of narration and background music. Ten seconds of a black screen will follow the video project.



Equipment needed

Table-top video system, videocassette recorder, television or video monitor, microphone, audio mixer, music source (audiocassette or CD player), headphones (optional).



Procedure

1. Select a topic for your project. Think about a topic that would make good use of the table-top video system. Get approval for your topic from the teacher.
2. Write a script about your topic. Make sure to include a description of the item that you are displaying.
3. Read your script aloud and make note of the time. The script should take at least one minute, and no more than two minutes for you to read. Make sure that you can correctly pronounce each word in your script. Make necessary changes in your script.
4. Select some instrumental music that would compliment your project.
5. Practice reading your script aloud. Practice it again....and again!
6. Record your project. Remember to include:
 - silent “black” (10 seconds)
 - graphic (10 seconds)
 - video image with music and narration (1 – 2 minutes)
 - silent “black” (10 seconds)
7. Pay close attention as the process is demonstrated for you.



Evaluation

Your grade will consist of:

- Script (50 points)
- Selection and display of videotaped object (25 points)
- Graphic (10 points)
- Music (5 points)
- Overall impression (10 points)
